I have worked with Atlas Excavating, Inc., on many projects, including the most recently the Low Pressure Sanitary Sewer Barrett Law project in Noblesville, Indiana. This was a challenging project with confined construction limits and restricted site access. Atlas fielded a crew of trained professionals who worked very closely with the owner, engineer, and property owners to minimize the impact of this project where 99 homes were serviced.

The installation of the grinder stations was troublesome, and issues lingered well past the completion date. For this reason, we are omitting this phase of the project from this recommendation. The end result of this project, however, was a collection system that serviced an unincorporated area of the City of Noblesville that was installed with minimal impact to the residents, completed in a timely manner, and under budget.
